## **COVID-19 Statement**

The concessions and restrictions placed by the NSW Government on movement and activities during the COVID19 Pandemic are extremely fluid in nature. There is a strong possibility the measures needed to be taken by individuals and organisations may be significantly different between the date these Supplementary Regulations are published and the date of the event. It is therefore necessary the Event Website, Event Facebook Page, Rally NSW Website, Rally NSW Facebook Page be monitored for Bulletins and variations to the Supplementary Regulations prior to the event.

**Under no circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event.** This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue, or lack of sense of smell.

**Under no circumstances should anyone attend the event if they have been;**

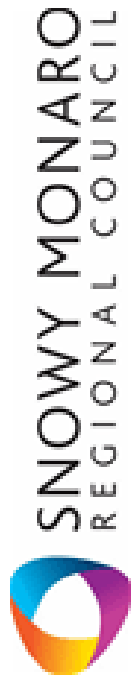
- i. overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- ii. in contact with someone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- iii. in contact with a known COVID-19 positive case in the previous 14 days.

It is highly recommended that if any participant exhibits symptoms consistent with COVID-19 prior to the event then the individual should take a COVID-19 test through NSW Health or their regular Doctor.

Motorsport Australia strongly encourages the use of the Australian Government's 'COVIDSafe App' for all event participants.

Many administrative and operational processes for the event may be very different to what has been normally experienced in the past. This may result in some activities taking longer than expected. Please allow additional time and tolerance during this difficult period so we can all participate and be involved in the sport we love. Please do read these Supplementary Regulations closely and in the lead up monitor for any applicable changes that may be made to the event as they become available.

Social distancing and other COVID-19 practices must be observed at all times.



## MESSAGE FROM CLERK OF COURSE

With the impact of the major bushfires and COVID19 in the Snowy Region, we made the decision to explore and run on new roads for the 2020 event, with the help of Forestry NSW. Maps and roads were provided, and Dave has outdone himself, plotting a fantastic course consisting of 189 kms of competitive stages with only 124 kms in transport.

The roads are in excellent condition, with a mixture of CAT4 forestry roads with tight and technical side sections incorporated, to give a wide variety of road types and surfaces. I promise you will not be disappointed.

Moving the event solely to the forest, to protect our shire road residents from COVID19, has enabled us to open the event to pacenotes. This has been hard to accomplish in the past due to shire road restrictions, but we are confident that the new forestry roads have the rhythm and smoothness of some of your favourite shire roads.

The pacenote OPTION is available to eligible Series competitors (NSWRC, ECCRS and ACT Series) but is not mandatory. Clubman and HRS need to run on roadbook (Blind event) to be eligible for their Series points. As per Rally NSW conditions, an extensive roadbook will be provided to all competitors whether running pacenotes or blind. All Series outright/category positions and point scores will be determined at the end of the pacenote section, which will be 10 stages.

There will be an additional 2 stages for roadbook only competitors. The positions at the end of the additional stages will have no bearing on Series positions or point scores but will determine the overall winner of the host event.

We are also providing an Regularity Rally which will be roadbooked and consists of 4 stages and total 68kms competitive.

We have been welcomed by Brian, who runs **Bondi Forest Lodge**, which will be our Rally HQ for the event. The lodge sleeps up to 72 people, has showers and toilets and a fantastic grassed area for camping. It also has kitchens and lovely wood burning heaters for crews to use, and a main mess hall. Our service park will be a hop, step and jump from the Lodge. **Skymesh Pty Ltd** have provided Rally HQ with satellite NBN internet connection, to keep our crews safe and we are very grateful for their support.

This year we have decided to forgo our presentation and replace it with a celebration of the event. Provisional results will be handed out at the conclusion of the event. The **Lions Club of Bombala** will be providing food, with **Jindabyne Brewing** and **Wildbrumby Schnapps** coming on board to help with the celebrations. I'm sure yarns around a fire-drum will be well received and will top off the great event we have planned.

This year, the 2019 Monaro Stages was nominated by the Snowy Monaro Regional Council for an award in the **2019 Australia Day Awards**, for best local event – the award bearing testimony to the club, organising committee and the team that puts this event together.

Our thanks again to Andrew & Georgina from **Kosciuszko Automotive** for their sponsorship and support for the Monaro Stages. We greatly appreciate their support over the past 4 years. This year we welcome onboard **Jindabyne Brewing** and welcome back wonderful sponsors, **Lazer Lamps** and **Wildbrumby Schnapps**.

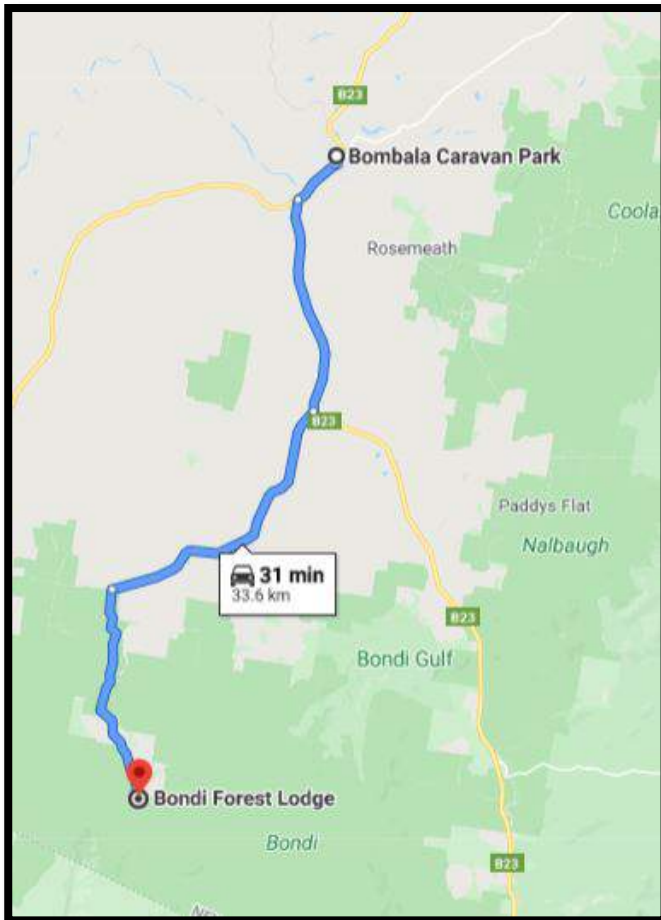
## EVENT SUMMARY

### General Information

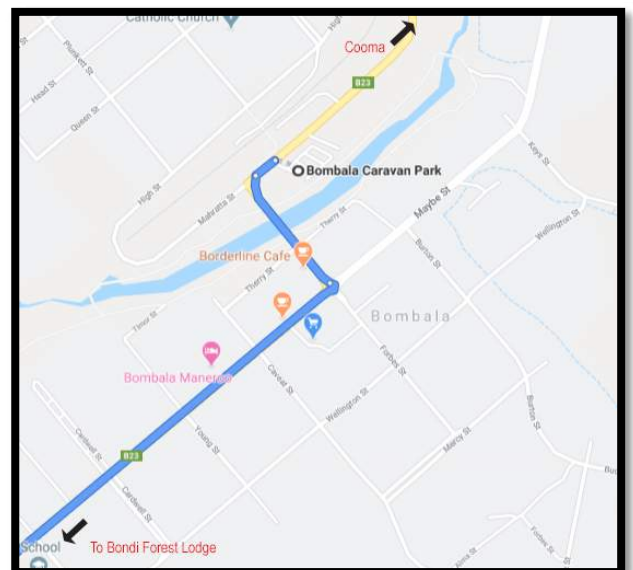
The 2020 Kosciuszko Automotive Monaro Stages will start and finish at the Bondi Forest Lodge on Buldah Road.

Service Park for the event is part of the Bondi Forest Lodge area and is adjacent to the buildings that will be used for accommodation and Rally HQ. All servicing will be done at the Bondi Service Park.

2020 Kosciuszko Automotive Monaro Stages will be based out of Bondi Forest Lodge and run in the Bondi and Craigie Forests surrounding the Lodge. The lodge is approx. 34kms from Bombala. The smaller town map of Bombala, shows the direction from Bombala Caravan Park (which was next to the 2018/2019 event Service Park)



From Bombala:-

Head south-west on Mahratta St/Monaro Hwy B23

Turn left on Forbes Street/Monaro Hwy B23

At the roundabout, take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto Maybe St/Monaro Hwy B23

2.3km – turn left to stay on Monaro Hwy B23

9.0km – turn right onto Mila Road

12.5km – turn left onto Buldah Road

9.4km – Bondi Forest Lodge

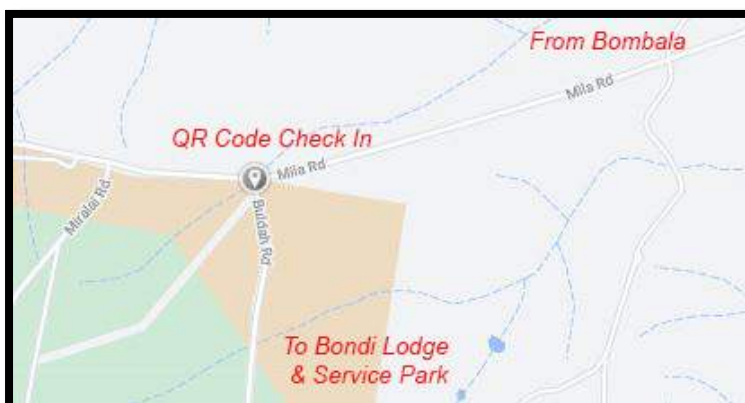
### QR CODE – CHECK IN POINT

We now have a Service NSW QR code which will be used to ensure contactless check-in to Monaro Stages event precinct, service park and all areas associated with the event.

Please download the Service NSW App and/or QR scanner app on your phone before you arrive so this process is quick and painless. This is the preferred method of check in.

If you have a phone that will not support this application, we have facilities here that will capture your information, the old fashioned way.

**VIA QR CODE CHECK IN POINT – all attendees at event must pass by the check in point for access to all event areas. Once checked in, you will receive a wrist band which MUST remain on your person until you leave the EVENT.**

## **SERVICE PARK RULES**

**PLEASE DO NOT ENTER SERVICE PARK – UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN CHECKED IN AND RECEIVED YOUR IDENTIFYING WRIST BAND**

**PLEASE FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS OF OFFICIALS IN AND OUTSIDE SERVICE PARK**

### **Service Bay Allocation**

Service Bays will be allocated as per the service park layout plan. Consideration will be given to:-

- Service Vehicles – trucks, cars, service sharing etc.
- Specific requests MUST be notified to Event Secretary prior to Wednesday 28/10/20 and we will do our best to plan accordingly

### **Speed Limit in Service Park**

Speed in Service Park is STRICTLY WALKING PACE – **20kms per hour**

Please also note the direction of travel in Service Park as indicated by red arrows on the Service Park Layout Plan

### **Refuelling in Service Park**

**There is NO pump fuel available near the Service Park. No 98 fuel is available in Bombala. Competitors will need to provide their own fuel supply.**

- All refuelling will be done at Service Park – there are no remoted refuel points for this event.
- A refuel location and fuel dump are within the Service Park (see plan)
- No refuelling is to be done in Service Bays
- All fuel containers must be clearly marked with your Car Number and placed in the Fuel Dump zone upon arrival
- Service Park is a smoke free zone. Please DO NOT smoke in the Service Park

### **Servicing**

All servicing will be done at the Bondi Service Park.

- Tarps are required to be used under Rally Cars during Service activities
- Stable vehicle stands must be used when Rally Cars are raised off the ground.

No service vehicle may drive on a competitive stage during the running of the Event without the express permission of the Clerk of Course. If vehicle recovery is required, service crews are asked to contact Rally Headquarters for instruction.

### **General**

General Rules that will apply:-

- Monaro Stages Service Park is a smoke free zone. Please DO NOT smoke in Service Park
- No alcohol may be consumed in the Service Park or Rally Precinct until cessation of competition
- Any camp BBQ's must be a suitable distance from tents and vehicles
- No open fires are to be lit EXCEPT in approved fire pit structures
- Service Bays are to be kept clean and free of rubbish. Please bring a supply of garbage bags for general waste and take your rubbish with you when you leave. Bondi Forest Lodge complex is an isolated site.
- Covid-19 restrictions and guidelines must be followed at all times.

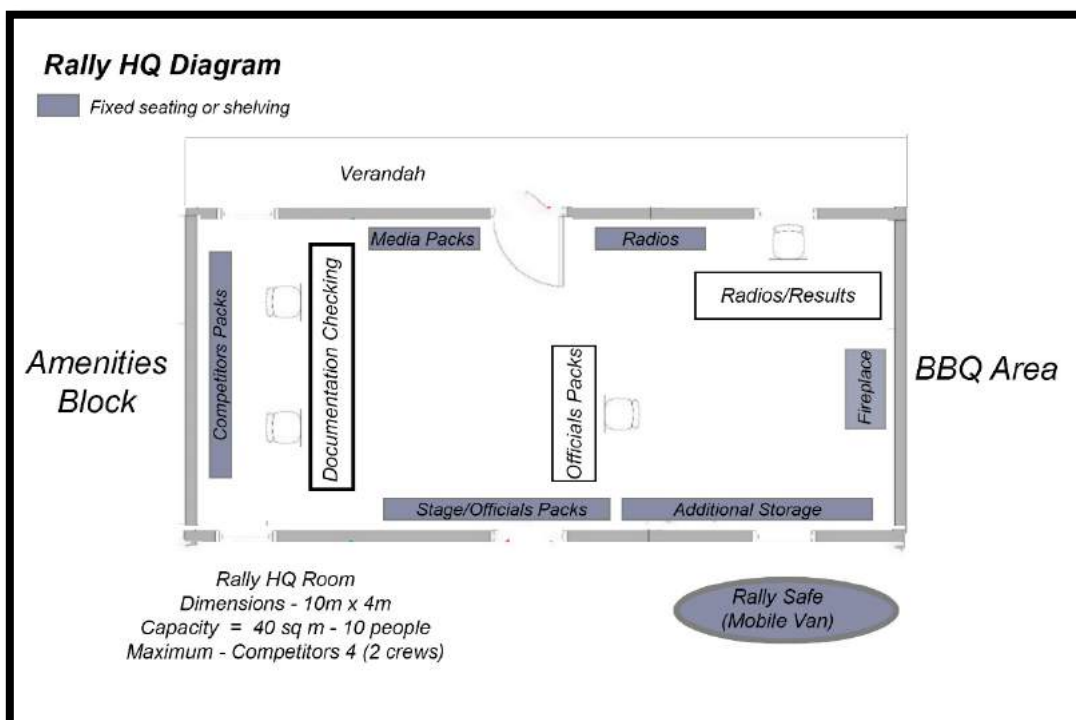


# RALLY HEADQUARTERS PLAN

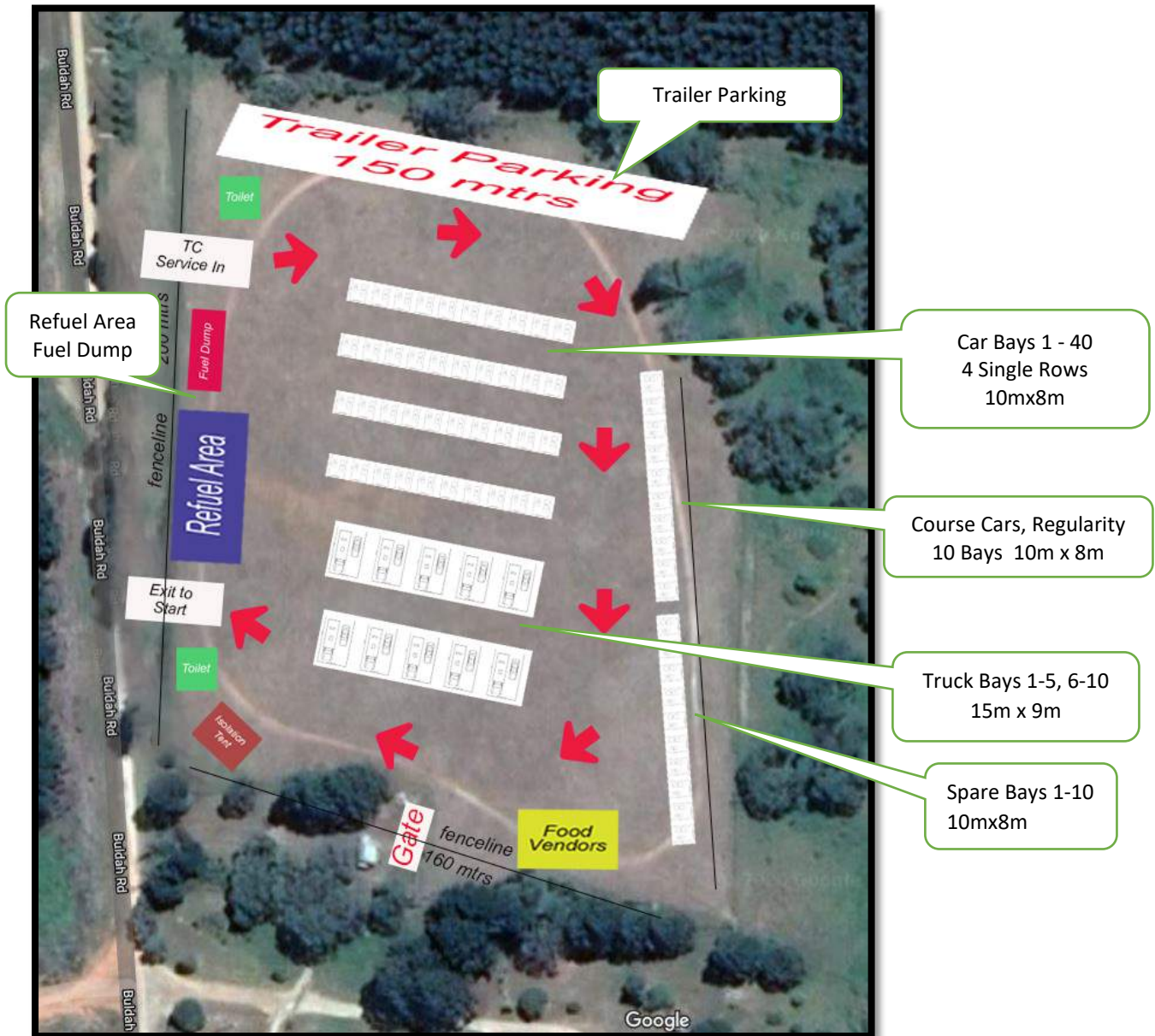
- A – Rally HQ

10 Truck Service bays 15mx9m Truck Service Bay space = 135m<sup>2</sup>

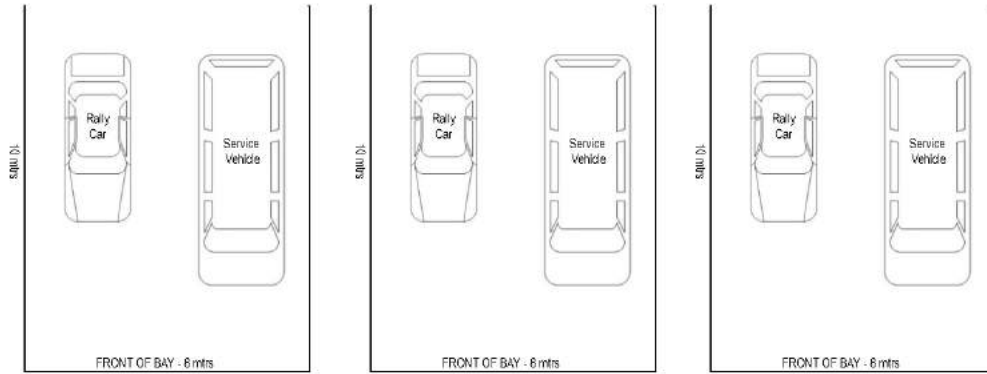
Service Bay space (less used vehicle space) = 60m<sup>2</sup>
